Our Clients, the proud owners of a landmark 1860's era Italianate home, desired to greatly improve their daily ingress and egress experience. With a growing young family, the lack of a proper entry area and attached garage was something they wanted to address. They also needed a guest suite to accommodate frequent out-of-town guests and visitors. But in the homeowner's own words, "He didn't want to be known as the guy who 'screwed up' this beautiful old home". Our design challenge was to provide the needed space of a significant addition, but do so in a manner that would respect the historic home. Our design solution lay in providing a "hyphen": a multi-functional daily entry breezeway connector linking the main house with a new garage and in-law suite above. DIRECTIONS > From Main Street (downtown Ann Arbor) take West Huron Street heading west to the Dexter/Ann Arbor Road and Jackson Road split. Stay to the right following Dexter/Ann Arbor road west to Dexter where it becomes Main Street. At the center of town, turn right heading northeast on Broad Street. Project is just north of the intersection of Broad and Huron.
